Government of Nepal (GON) has received financing from the International Development Association (IDA), towards the cost of Modernization of Rani Jamara Kulariya Irrigation Scheme – Phase 2 and intends to apply part of the proceeds for Consulting Services for **“Design Review, Construction Supervision, Quality Control, Contract Management and Safeguard Monitoring for Implementation of MoRJKIS Phase 2 ”**. The consulting team will assist RJKIP and ACIU in implementation of MoRJKIS Phase 2 activities. The consultant shall provide advice, assistance to the project institutions regarding all aspects of implementation so that the project achieves its objectives.

The scope of the consulting services is to review and detail the preliminary designs, drawings, technical specifications, quantity and cost estimate, revise the preliminary designs/specifications if needed, issue a method statement for the contractor, conduct quality assurance and control with overall construction management and Safeguard Monitoring for Implementation of Modernization of Rani Jamara Kulariya Irrigation Scheme Phase 2.

The short listing will be carried out based on the following criteria:

- General experiences of the firm,
- Specific experiences of the firm,
- Availability of key professional staff,
- Financial information for last 5 years,

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraphs 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of The World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016 Revised November 2017 (“Procurement Regulations”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

Consulting firms may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A consulting firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) Method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
